The Women's Honor Court, Inc., and Henderson County have joined together to add another granite wall to the park located at 16 South Water Street, Henderson, KY.. The Women's Honor Court was built and dedicated in September 2014. Landscape Designer Bradley Vowels and Architect Tim Skinner worked with the Design Committee on the original design of the Women's Honor Court.

Anyone who wished to honor a woman who was significant in his or her life may submit that woman's name which will be inscribed on the granite wall for a donation of **\$1100** or above.

The WHC Committee is suggesting that family members may go together as a group to recognize and honor any woman—a mother, grandmother, or teacher—with her name on the wall for a donation of **\$1100** or above. The combined donations for a woman must be sent in with one form along with a total of **\$1100** or above listing all persons making the joint contribution.

Contributions in any amount will be acknowledged in a commemorative booklet.
